NOTE

- The accommodation will require a refundable safety deposit of 150 GBP. The deposit will be fully refundable after the student check-out if there is no damage to the facilities and no violations of the rules of the accommodation; otherwise, it will be deducted from the deposit. Rates are valid from 1st January 2025 until 31st December 2025 and are subject to a 5% increase, for all bookings on or after 01st January 2026. The 5% increase will also apply to accommodation bookings that continue into 2026 but that started in 2025.
- Minimum age: 16
- Students are entitled to a one-week holiday every term (12 weeks). The student must inform the Student Services Department at least one week in advance of the holiday; otherwise, it would be counted as an absence. Students are advised to carefully consider their visa validity before taking holidays
- Students are entitled to pause the course only once during their time at ES. The Student Services Department will issue a voucher for the remaining weeks; however, the combined pause time cannot exceed 6 months.

PAYMENT T&C

Tuition fees 2025

Full course fees must be received four weeks before the start date of the course to allow time for processing the admission. If the payment is received less than four weeks before the start of the course, the start date may be deferred. Fees can be paid by cash, cheque, credit card, nexpay or bank transfer. Bank charges for sending and receiving banks are payable by the sender. Payments by credit card and online payments are subject to a surcharge of 3%.

Start date

It may be possible to defer your course start date 30 days prior to the original course start date.

Cancellation policy

If a student's visa application is rejected after payment has been received, all tuitions fees, excluding any non-refundable fees detailed in the Cancellation Policy below.

ES Training defines "cancellation" as a change occurring before the course first confirmation letter date. The following refund policies are in effect for all cancellations sent via email to the concerned ES Advisor: Enrollment fees, non-refundable deposits related to offers or promotions, bank fees, courier fees, booking fees, visa fees, admin fees, and third-party fees (agent commission) are non-refundable. The processing of the refunds will be within 60 calendar days and based on the following terms:

- A. Upon receiving the cancellation request 30 days prior to the course start date of the first offer letter, 100% of the amount paid will be refunded (except any non-refundable fees*).
- B. Upon receiving the cancellation request 14 days prior to the course start date of the first offer letter, 50% of the amount paid will be refunded (except any non-refundable fees*).
- C. Upon receiving the cancellation request 7 days prior to the course start date of the first offer letter, 20% of the amount paid will be refunded (except any non-refundable fees*).
- D. No refund will be provided for any cancellation request received after any of the above-mentioned time periods.

Accommodation cancellation policy

If you want to cancel your accommodation booking:

- A. 30 days or more prior to arrival: Full refund (booking fee not refundable).
- B. 29 to 8 days prior to arrival: one week of cancellation fee
- C. 7 to 3 days prior to arrival: two weeks of cancellation fee
- D. 2 days or less prior to arrival or "no show" four weeks of cancellation fee. If the stay is equal or less than four weeks, you will get no refund

If you want to leave before your check-out date, you will not be refunded.

This agreement is a binding contract and by signing below, you agree that you have read, understood, and agreed to the terms and conditions in this document.

Withdrawal policy

ES Training defines withdrawal as the termination of a course after the course has started. Any withdrawal must be requested through the student ticket system on the student portal, to arrange all the relevant visa issues and cancellations in time before the student's last day. No tuition fees will be refunded to students who notify ES Training of their withdrawal after the commencement of their course.
